Ethics is very important in the management of the project. Each project manager should act to the highest personal and professional ethical standards towards team members, colleagues, employees, employers, clients and the public.

The project manager is also required to be able to resolve conflict situations, as well as to control the proper course of project implementation, which can also cause stress.

A stressful situation can be caused not only by problems arising in the team. It may also concern organisational or substantive matters related to, for example, timely completion of the task, budget change during project implementation, change of key contractors for individual tasks/stages, acquisition of key experts to carry out or supervise specific orders, time constraints and timely submission of reports and settlements, and all other unlisted situations that may contribute to stress and conflict.
