

EXAMPLES FOR THE TRAINER

In accordance with the proposal contained in the draft act, remote work will be work performed entirely or partially in a place indicated by the employee and each time agreed with the employer, including at the address of residence, in particular using means of direct remote communication.

The above means that work can be performed full-time as remote work or only partially as remote work, e.g., 2 days a week at the employer's headquarters and 3 days at the employee's place of residence. Employers need to think about modern solutions regarding e.g., circulation of documents or an easy way to regulate the cost of remote work by an employee.
