

WORK CARD 1 SMART



The aim of this task is to provide participants with practical experience in developing training goals in accordance with the adopted SMART standards and methodology.

In groups, choose a training topic related to any field of work or interest. Then, develop training goals for your chosen topic.

SMART method: specific, measurable, achievable, relevant and time-bound.

The examples of learning objectives for two different training topics:

Training topic no. 1: Project management in a business environment

- Participants will be able to define project objectives, identifying key results and success indicators.
- Participants will acquire the ability to develop a project schedule, including setting milestones and deadlines for completing tasks.
- Participants will learn to identify and manage project risks by creating a risk management plan and applying appropriate strategies.
- Participants will learn the ability to communicate effectively within a project team, including delegating tasks, conducting meetings and reporting progress.

 Participants will gain the ability to assess project progress and use appropriate monitoring and control tools and techniques.

Training topic np. 2: Interpersonal communication and building relationships in the workplace

- Participants will learn to listen actively and express themselves clearly, improving communication skills and preventing misunderstandings.
- Participants will acquire the ability to deal with conflicts and negotiate, using effective problem-solving strategies.
- Participants will learn to build positive relationships with coworkers and superiors, using techniques to build trust and empathy.
- Participants will master virtual communication and time management skills, taking into account various communication channels and online tools.
- Participants will acquire the ability to use body language and gestures to effectively convey information and build interpersonal relationships.

These sample learning objectives can provide a starting point for developing more detailed lesson plans and training programs for each topic.
