



## Learning without borders

The project "Studium bez hranic III" ("Study without borders") was implemented by: Business School, Secondary Special School for Librarians and Further Education College in Brno. The partner is London's ADC College. The target group is students of the 2nd and 3rd grade of the academy and business high school, who have already studied economics, languages or new technologies, as well as communication and management courses.

A total of 30 students took part in a 2-week work experience in London, where they actively worked in enterprises under the mentorship of company representatives. During this time, they learned the rules of presenting the results of their projects to mentors, colleagues and clients. This caused them to improve their communication and stress management skills.

The goals of the project include improvement of language skills, development of communication, social and personal competences, as well as the use of newly learned methods from the visited country and their popularisation during further study and work exeprience The organisers point out that although the event itself lasts 2 weeks, its effects, due to the planned dissemination of the methods learned, are long-term.
