Objective: To select the most appropriate alternative and additionally rank other best alternatives.



Method: A detailed, refined comparison between appropriate alternatives. Focus on the differences between the alternatives, pointing out the most appropriate alternative. Ask yourself: How likely is it that I will be able to actualize it?

- If no: select second best alternative(s);
- If yes: How confident am I in my choice, on a scale of 1-10 (where 10 is the highest)?;
- If the answer is 7 and below: Go back to the detailed research stage (Worksheet 5);
- If the answer is yes: Done!



Result: One selected alternative or a ranking of alternatives in order of priority.
