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CASE STUDY 1

WORKING EFFECTIVELY IN A DISTRIBUTED TEAM USING A CLOUD ENVIRONMENT IN THE ECONOMICS AND ADMINISTRATION

Situation:

FENIX GmbH, a company in the economics and administration industry, decided to implement distributed team working to increase flexibility, enable access to talent from different locations and reduce operational costs. Employees, including accountants, financial analysts and administrators, were distributed across different geographical locations. FENIX GmbH management highlighted the need for a cloud environment to enable the distributed team to work seamlessly and securely.

The solution:

FENIX GmbH implemented a cloud environment, which became the primary tool to enable employees to work effectively in a distributed team. Employees had access to a shared workspace in the cloud where they could store, share and work together on documents, spreadsheets and presentations. 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As part of the cloud environment, FENIX GmbH also used online communication and collaboration tools. Video conferencing platforms, group chats and discussion forums enabled employees to communicate in real time, exchange information and ideas and solve problems on the fly. Regular virtual meetings, both team and individual, kept team members in touch and strengthened relationships.

Data security was also a priority for FENIX GmbH. Security measures such as multi-level authentication and encryption of data stored on disks were implemented.
